## Terms and Conditions

### Reservation and Final Payment

A \$300 deposit is required to secure a reservation for your tour date due August 1, 2015. Team size will be limited and applications accepted on a first come – first served basis. Pricing based on minimum of 20 passengers. Final payment must be received by November 15, 2015. Payment can be made by check. Payments not received in time will result in reservation cancellation without refund.

### Cancellation

### Airline Security

It is the passenger's responsibility to provide positive identification in the form of a passport or other required identification at the time of airport check-in.

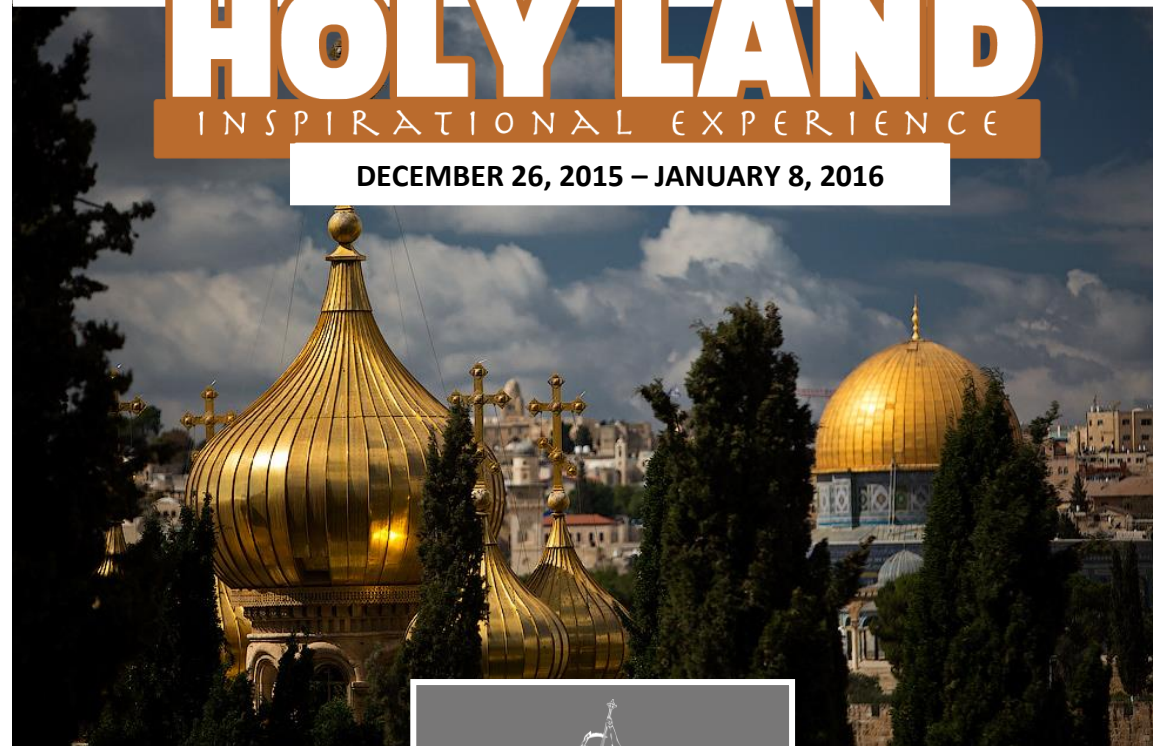
