# DAY-BY-DAY ITINERARY

#### NEWARK/ACROSS THE ATLANTIC MONDAY, OCTOBER 23

Depart today from Newark on board your overnight transatlantic jet flight, arriving in Berlin the following day.

### ARRIVE BERLIN

**TUESDAY, OCTOBER 24** Arrive in historic Berlin where you will be met and escorted to your waiting motorcoach for the transfer to your hotel. **(D)** 

#### BERLIN

#### WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 25

This morning visit reunited Berlin. In the former West, see Charlottenburg Castle, Kaiser Wilhelm Memorial Church, the famous Kurfurstendamm, Bellevue Castle, the Cultural Forum and the Reichstag Building. In former Eastern Berlin, see the Brandenburg Gate at the end of beautiful Unter Den Linden Boulevard, Gendarmen Markt, the Berlin Cathedral, Alexanderplatz, the Nikolai Quarter, and the remains of the Berlin Wall. The afternoon is free to explore Berlin on your own. **(B)** 

#### BERLIN/WITTENBERG/LEIPZIG THURSDAY, OCTOBER 26

This morning depart Berlin and drive via Potsdam to Wittenberg, the city where Luther's activities reached a high point. As a professor of philosophy and theology at Wittenberg University, Martin Luther made his public appearance by nailing

his 95 Theses against the misuse of the indulgence system to the door of the Castle Church, sparking the Reformation movement. Visit the Castle Church, see the Luther Monument in the marketplace, Luther's grave and the City Church of St. Mary where Luther did most of his preaching. Also visit Lutherhalle, his dwelling in the Augusteum, which is now a museum of Reformation history containing an unsurpassed collection of Reformation artifacts. Continue to Leipzig for overnight. **(B,D)** 

#### LEIPZIG

#### FRIDAY, OCTOBER 27

Leipzig, classic city of fairs, books and music, is home to the 13th century Thomas Church immortalized by Bach, where he served as cantor and choir director. It was here in 1519 that Luther debated Johann Eck, and denied the divine origin of papal supremacy. Enjoy a panoramic tour of the city with an afternoon at leisure for further group activities. (B,D)

#### LEIPZIG/EISENACH/WARTBURG/MARBURG SATURDAY, OCTOBER 28

Continue to Eisenach, a refuge for Luther during the stormy days before the Reformation. Visit Wartburg Castle, set on a mountaintop overlooking the city and one of the bestpreserved German medieval fortresses. Here Luther worked on a translation of the New Testament, and Richard Wagner, inspired by the Thuringian scenery, wrote the opera, "Tannhauser." See Luther's study, the Reformation room and the lovely paintings by Lucas Cranach the Elder. Also worth viewing is the impressive "Angel with Candlestick," painted by Tilman Riemenschneider in 1500. In the city, visit the Luther House and make a brief stop at St. George Church where Luther preached. Next continue to Marburg, a bustling medieval university town for overnight. **(B,D)** 

#### MARBURG/ZURICH

#### **SUNDAY, OCTOBER 29**

This morning enjoy an orientation tour of Marburg and view the castle where the ill-fated meeting between Martin Luther and Ulrich Zwingli took place. Marburg is also home to the first Protestant university in the world. It is the town where the Brothers Grimm collected and edited German folktales and laid the foundations for comparative linguistics and cultural anthropology. Next travel south via Frankfurt crossing the border into Switzerland. Continue past the border city of Basel to Zurich, located along the banks of the Limmat River. Zurich, a present-day metropolis and important financial hub is a central city with many ties to the Reformation. **(B,D)** 

#### ZURICH

#### MONDAY, OCTOBER 30

Today tour the key Reformation sites. Visit Ulrich Zwingli's church, the massive gothic Grossmünster, founded by Charlemagne. Zwingli preached from its pulpit for 12 years. Stroll through the historic Auld Stadt (old city) and tour the Guild Hall and Museum with displays and art from the Swiss Reformation. View Zurich's renowned Catholic cathedral, Fraumunster Church, with its world-famous Chagall-stained glass windows. Overnight in Zurich. (B)



#### ZURICH/GENEVA

#### **TUESDAY, OCTOBER 31**

Journey through Switzerland's breathtakingly beautiful Bernese Oberland. Drive through stunning Alpine scenery to Geneva, center of the Reformation. Located on the tip of Lake Geneva and surrounded by the Alps and Jura mountains, the city of Geneva features outstanding scenic views, including the famous Mont Blanc. Upon arrival, enjoy an orientation tour of the city. View the waterfront, famous for its Flower Clock and English Gardens. See the United Nations Complex located in the Palais des Nations building constructed for the League of Nations between 1929 and 1938. Overnight in Geneva. **(B)** 

## GENEVA

#### WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 1

This morning, on your tour of Geneva you will follow in the footsteps of John Calvin. Begin by visiting St. Peter's Cathedral, where Calvin preached and which is built on the site of a Roman Sanctuary, a 4<sup>th</sup> Century basilica and a 6<sup>th</sup> Century church. Proceed to the *Auditoire de Calvin* (Calvin's Academy), where the theologian taught. Next view the Reformation Monument, honoring four leaders of the Reformation. The rest of the day is at leisure to further explore the city of Geneva on your own. **(B)** 

# GENEVA/NEWARK

## THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 2

Your journey is over as you transfer to the airport and board your flight back to Newark, arriving the same day. (B)
