Based on an ancient legend that Christ’s cross burst into bloom at the moment of his death, this symbol reminds us of the renewal that comes through Jesus’ sacrifice. On Easter Sunday, we invite you to bring flowers to place into our cross at either our outdoors ‘sunrise service’ at 6:15am, or our regular 10am service.
